

BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma Performing
Arts (Dance)

SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS

This award follows on from the Key Stage 4 Dance courses, both the BTEC and GCSE and students following it must have a very keen interest in dance or be thinking of moving to employment in the performing arts industry.

It is intended that this course will use each student's skills and enthusiasm in dance to develop and increase awareness in performing within the school and the wider local community.

The BTEC Subsidiary Diploma is a two year, 6 unit qualification and is equivalent to one A Level. The course is taught in units which are continually assessed throughout the two years. The units covered are as follows: Performing to an Audience, Dance Performance, Choreographic Principles, The Healthy Performer, Applying Contemporary Dance and Jazz Dance. There is an expectation that students following the course will be involved in helping with dance clubs and take part themselves.
